## Introduction

The Quality and Accreditation Unit (ABET centre) has recently launched the Alumni Survey for 2022 cycle online. The survey has targeted the Engineering alumni of the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology at An-Najah National University who were graduated within the years 2006 and 2019.

The survey aimed at reviewing the Program Educational Objectives (PEOs) of our Engineering Programs to meet the international standards of Quality according to ABET – EAC Criteria, and taking feedback and information from our Alumni about their employability, career progress, and recent endeavours.

## Executive summary

A total number of 296 Engineering Alumni responded to the survey, 20 of them were from the Chemical Engineering Program.

Most of the respondents were among our graduates who graduated during the year 2019. 90% of the respondents were females.

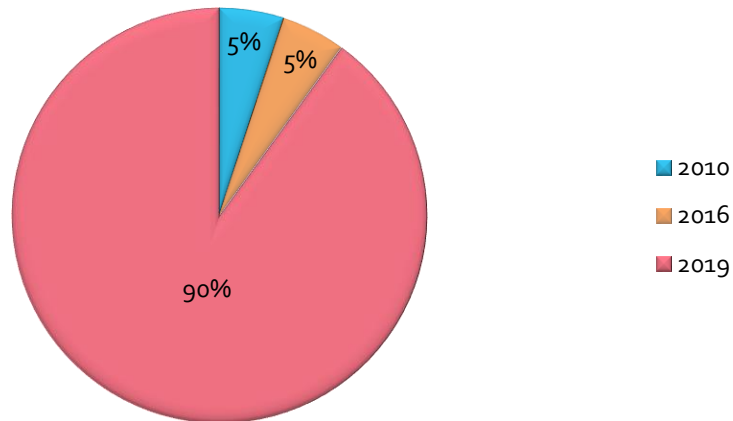
10% of the respondents have pursued graduate studies (master and/or PhD) or currently pursuing for it. Moreover, 50% of the respondents are currently employed, with a percentage of 100% work inside Palestine.

Chemical Engineering Program Alumni are employed in various professional positions that are widely spread among the employment sectors. For example, 60% of the Alumni work as Quality Engineer, and a percentage of 10% work as Project coordinator with a same percentage for those who work as a Manufacturing Engineer.

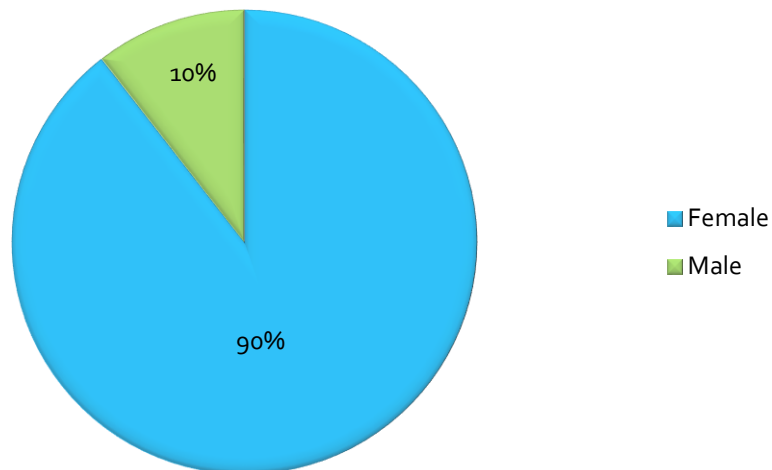

#### Gender



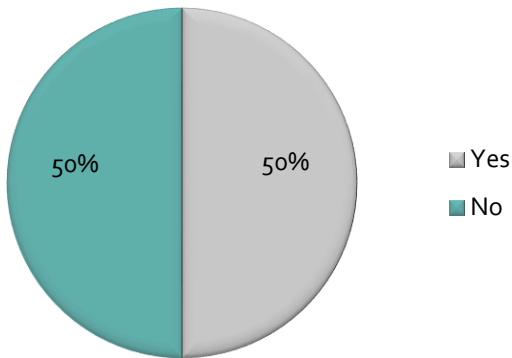
## Demographics

- 10% of the respondents were males, 90% were females.

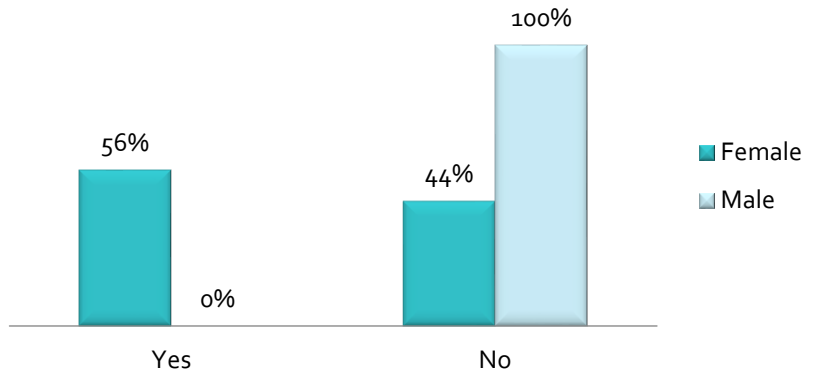

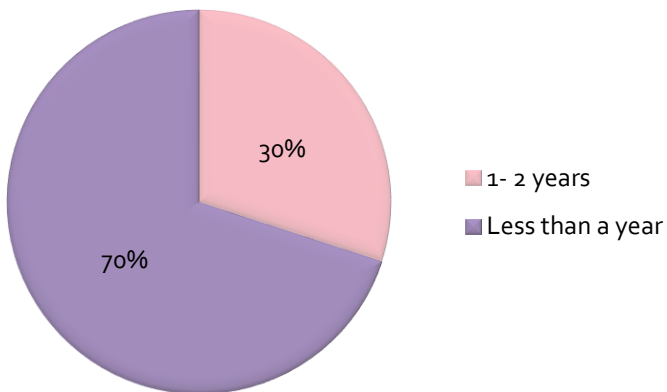
**Are You Employed Now?**



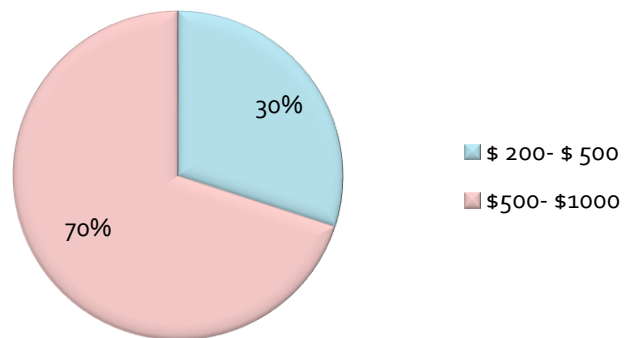
**Are You Employed Now?

**Period to First Work**



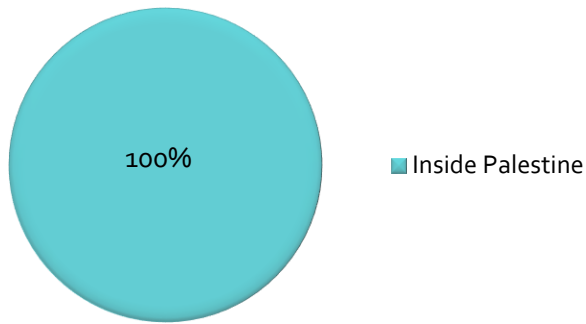
**Average Monthly Salary After

(First Work)**



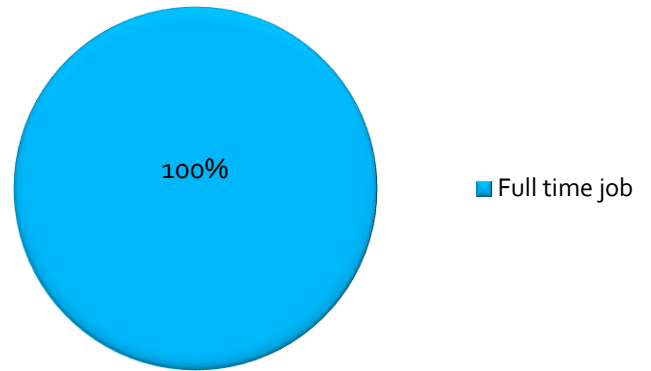
### Employability

- 70% of the respondents have an average monthly salary (first work) between \$500-\$1000.

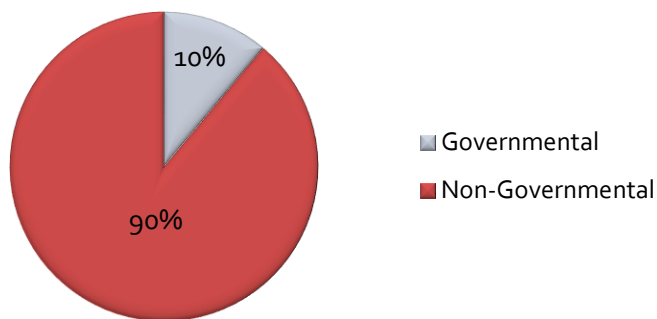
## Your Work Place?



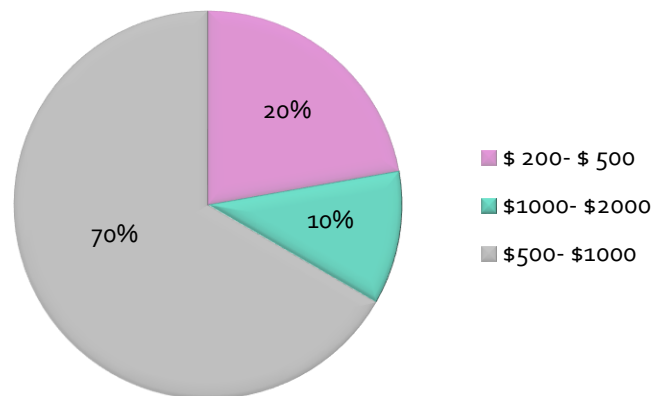

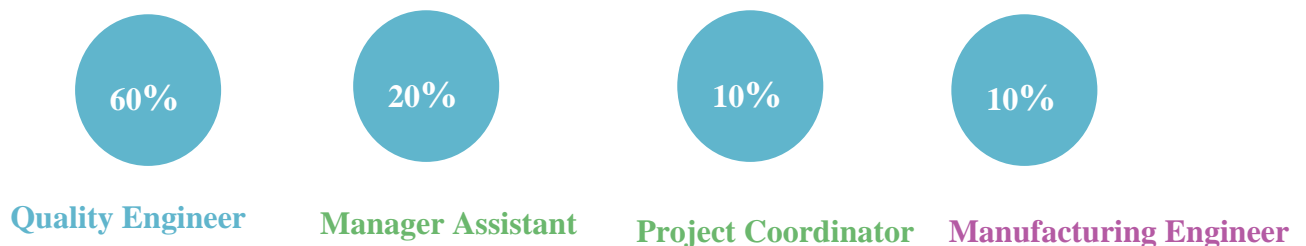

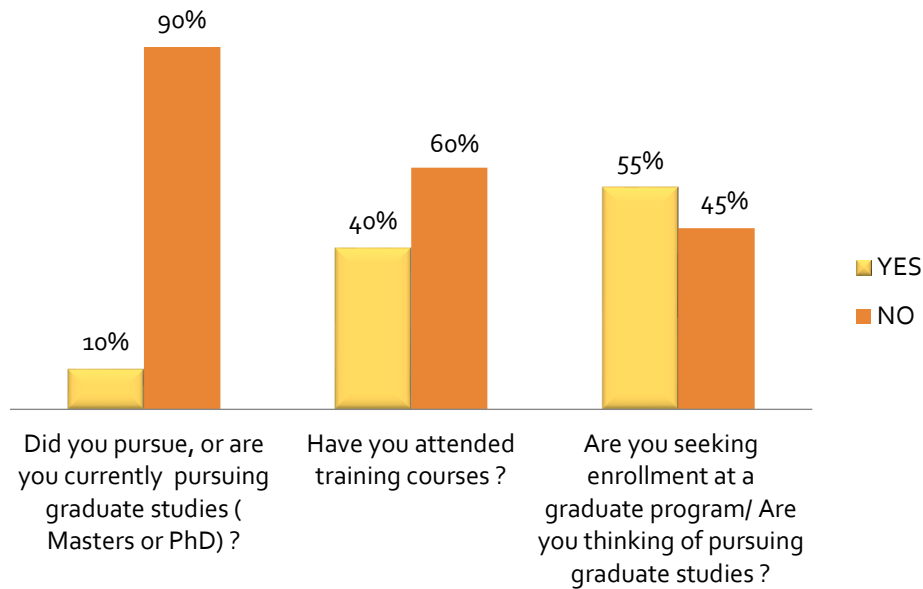
### Employability Status:
