

Introduction

The Quality and Accreditation Unit (ABET center) has recently launched the Alumni Survey for 2022 cycle online. The survey has targeted the Engineering alumni of the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology at An-Najah National University, who were graduated between 2006 to 2019.

The survey aimed at reviewing the Program Educational Objectives (PEOs) of our Engineering Programs to meet the international standards of Quality according to ABET – EAC Criteria, and taking feedback and information from our Alumni about their employability, career progress, and recent endeavours.



Executive summary

A total number of 296 Engineering Alumni responded to the survey, 57 of them were from the Building Engineering Program.

Most of the respondents were among our graduates in the academic years 2018 and 2019. Also, more than half of the respondents were females.

10% of the respondents have pursued graduate studies (master and/or PhD) or currently pursuing for it. Moreover, 68% of the respondents are currently employed, with a percentage of 92% of them work inside Palestine.


Building Engineering Program Alumni are employed in various professional positions that are widely spread among the employment sectors. For example, 26% of the Alumni work as Structural Engineers, and 15% as Site Engineers.



Gender




Demographics

- 67% of the respondents were females and 33% were males.




Are You Employed Now?




**Are You Employed Now?

Graduation and First Work**




**Your Average Monthly Salary After
Graduation (First Work)**




Employability

- 68% of our Alumni are currently employed.
- 69.2% of the respondents took less than a year to find their first job.
- 41.03% of the respondents have an average first monthly salary between \$200-\$500.


Your Work Place?




Type of Work



Type of Organization




Your Monthly Salary?



Employability Status:


- 87.2% of the employed respondents have a full time job.

Top Demanded Job Titles




It's worth mentioning that these jobs are also the same top jobs in the previous alumni survey in 2018.

Life Long Learning




- ❖ 10% of the respondents pursued or currently pursuing graduate studies (Masters, PhD).
