Introduction

The Quality and Accreditation Unit (ABET center) has recently launched the Alumni Survey for 2018 cycle online. The survey has targeted the Engineering alumni of the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology at An-Najah National University, who were graduated between 2006 to 2019.

The survey aimed at reviewing the Program Educational Objectives (PEOs) of our Engineering Programs to meet the international standards of Quality according to ABET – EAC Criteria, and taking feedback and information from our Alumni about their employability, career progress, and recent endeavours.

Executive summary

A total number of 296 Engineering Alumni responded to the survey, 56 of them were from the Computer Engineering Program.

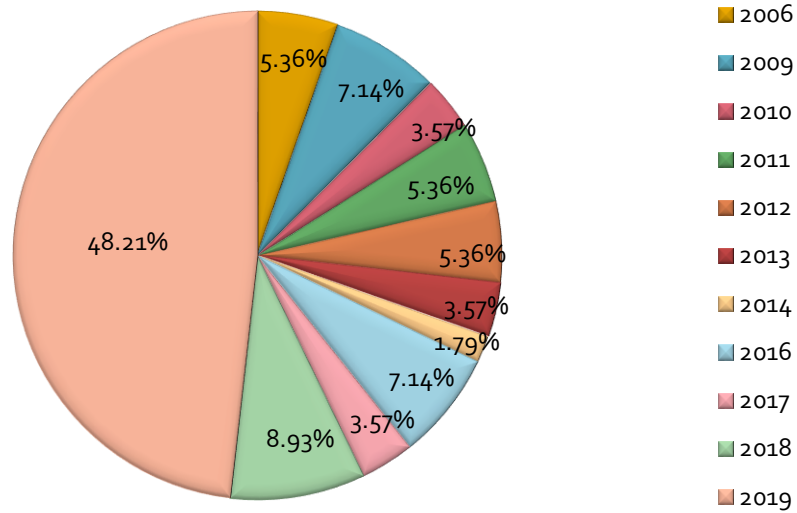
Most of the respondents were among our graduates in the year of 2019. Also, more than half of the respondents were males.

It's worth mentioning that 26% of the respondents have pursued graduate studies (master, PhD) or currently pursuing for it. Moreover, 77% of the respondents are currently employed, with a percentage of 91% work inside Palestine.

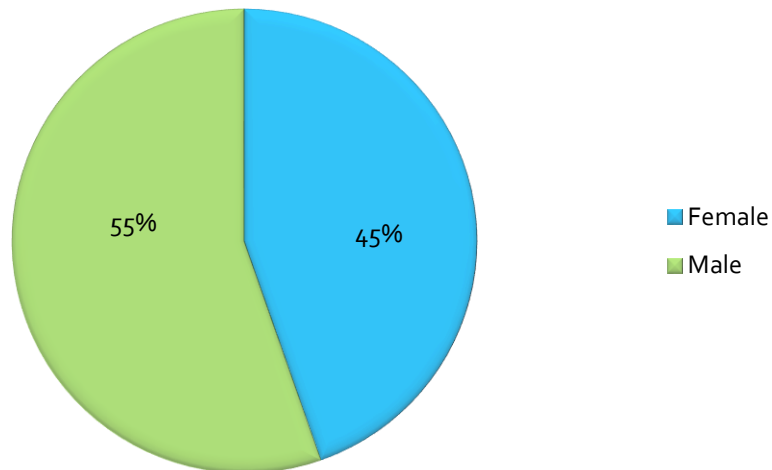

Gender



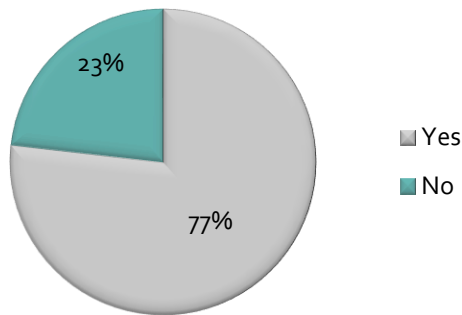
Demographics

- 55% of the respondents were males and 45% were females.

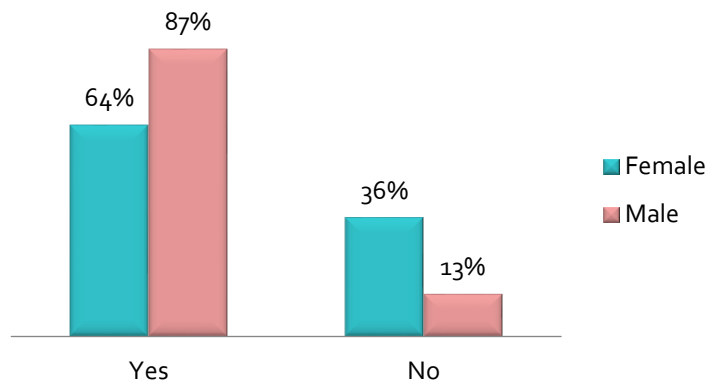

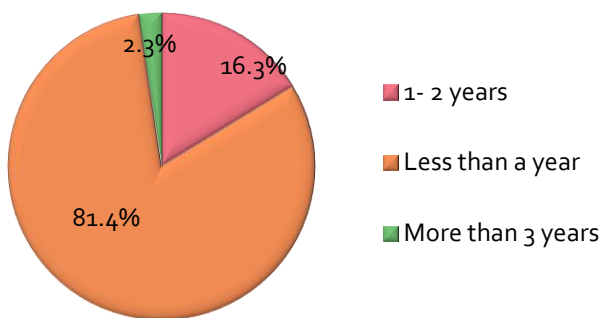
Are You Employed Now?



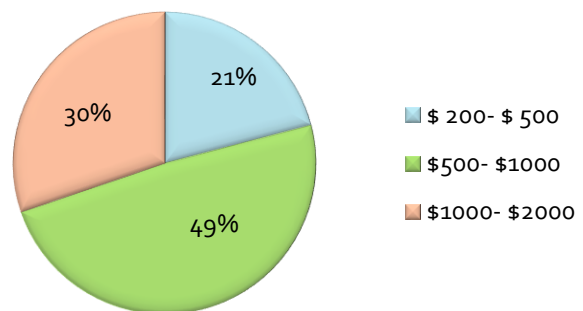
**Are You Employed Now?

Period to First Work



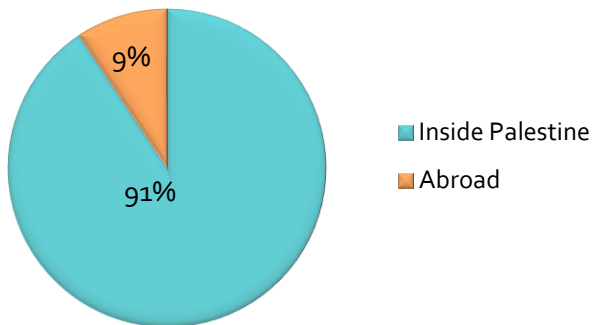
**Your Average Monthly Salary
After Graduation (First Work)**



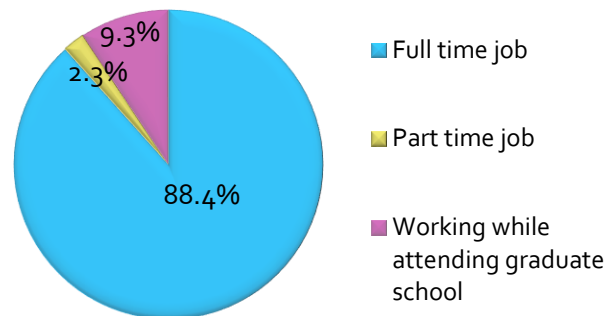
Employability

- 49% of the respondents have an average first monthly salary between \$500-\$1000.

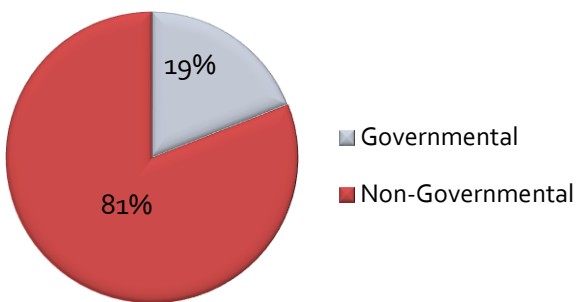
Your Work Place?



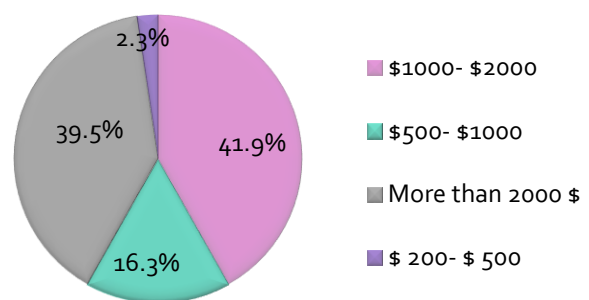
Type of Work

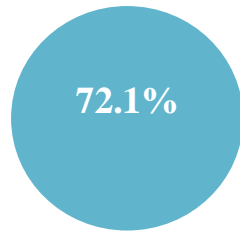
Your Monthly Salary?



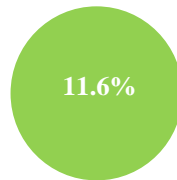
Employability Status:

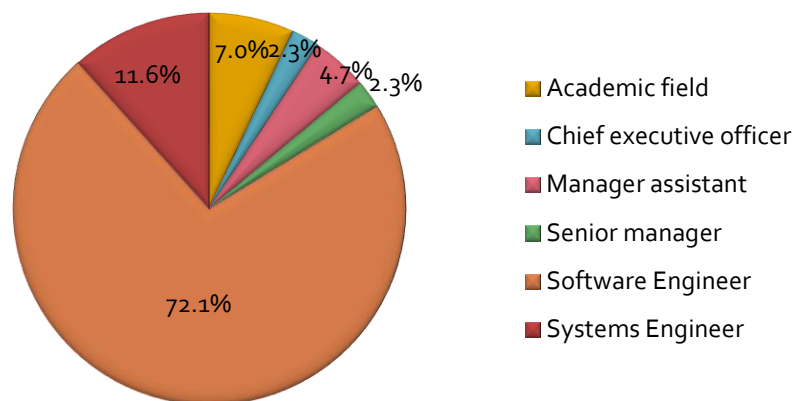

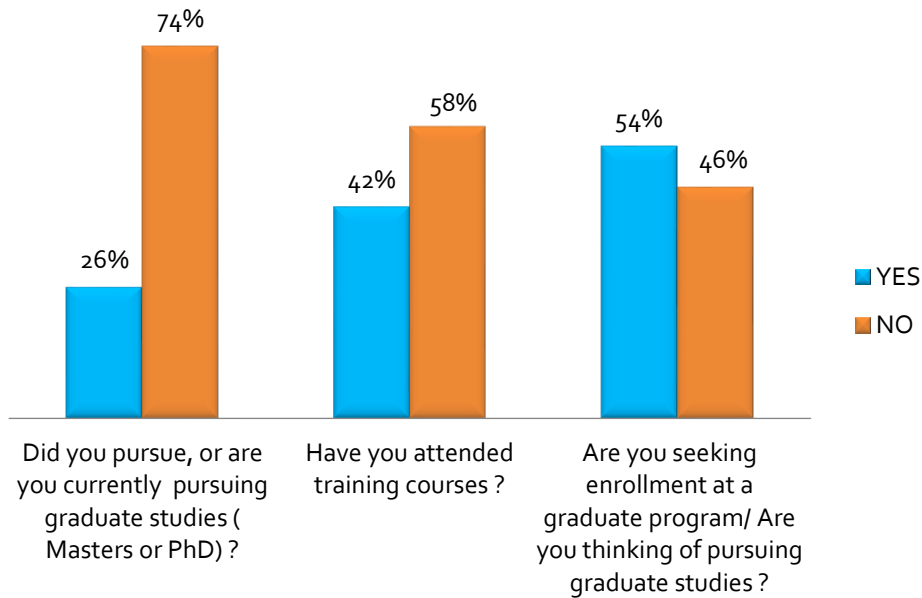

Your Job Title?

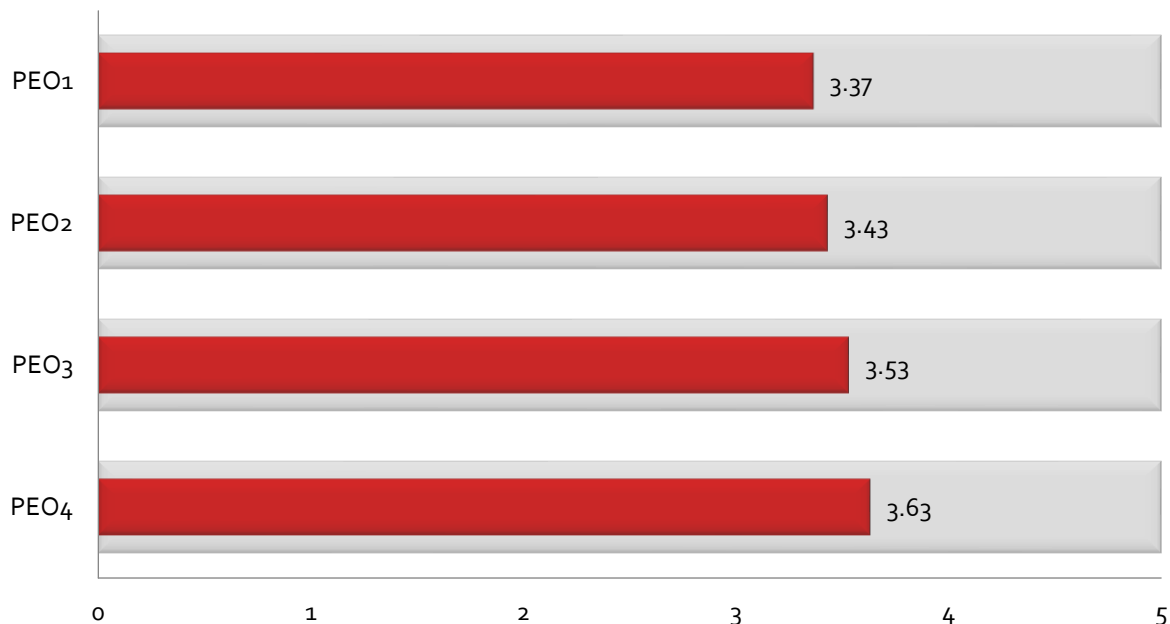


Life Long Learning
