Introduction

The Quality and Accreditation Unit (ABET centre) has recently launched the Alumni Survey 2014 online. The survey has targeted the alumni of the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology at An-Najah National University, who graduated from 2006 to 2013.

The survey aimed at reviewing the Program Educational Objectives (PEOs) of our Engineering Programs to meet the international standards of Quality (ABET), and taking feedback and information from our Alumni about their employability, career progression, and endeavours.

Executive Summary

A total number of 441 alumni responded to the survey, 9 of whom were from the Telecommunication Engineering Program.

Most of the respondents were from the graduation year 2013; also most of the respondents were males.

It's worth mentioning that 11% of the respondents pursued graduate studies (master, PhD) or currently pursuing for it, moreover 56% of the responded alumni are employed, and all of them work inside Palestine.

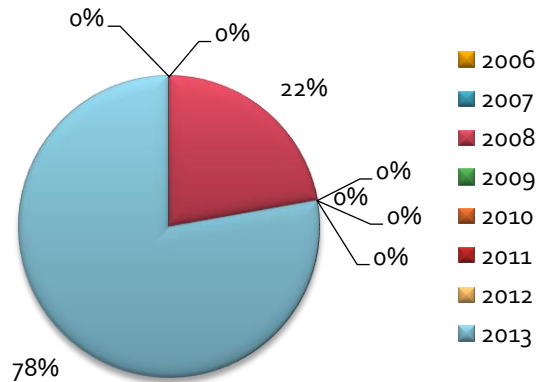
Telecommunication Engineering Program Alumni are employed in variety of professional positions that are widely spread among the employment sector of 40% as System Engineer, and equal percentage of 20% for all of Software Engineer, Chief Executive Engineer, and Process Engineer.

Finally, the Alumni of Telecommunication Engineering are satisfied of the newly rephrased Program Educational Objectives.

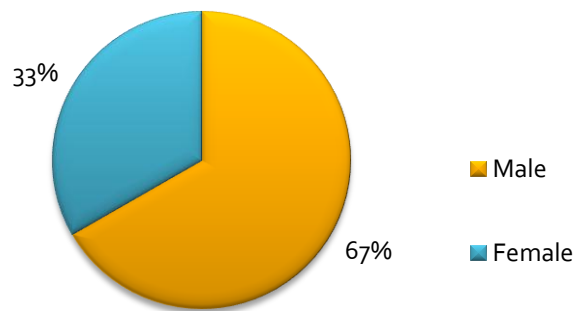

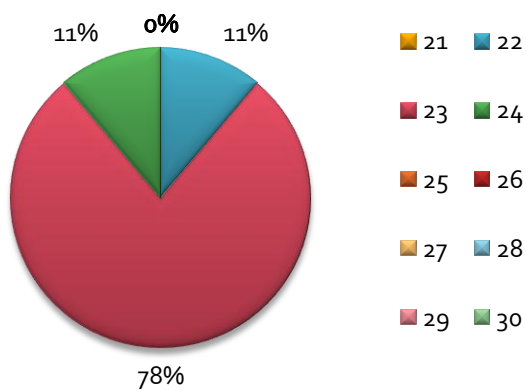
Year of graduation ?

Age ?

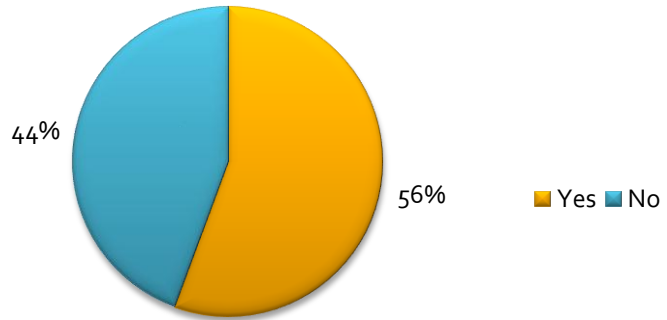


Demographics

- 78% of the respondents are in the age of 23.

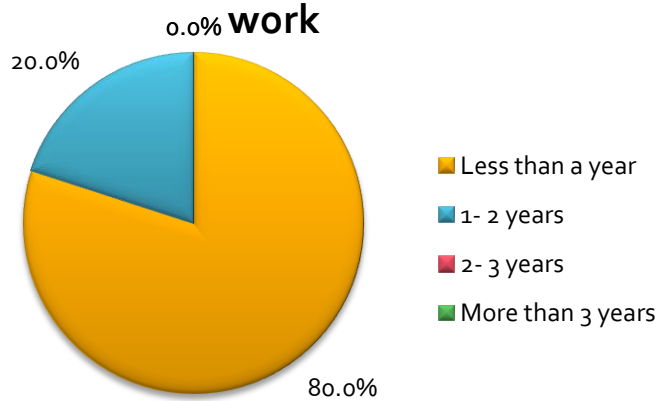

Are you employed now?

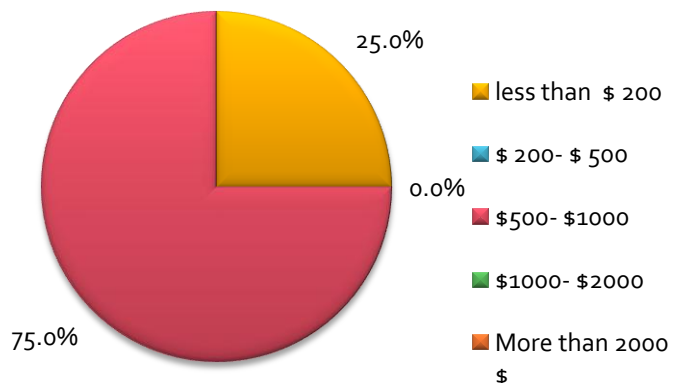

Period between graduation and first work



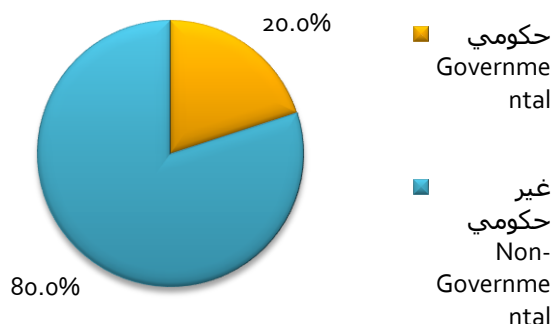
Your average monthly salary after graduation (first work).



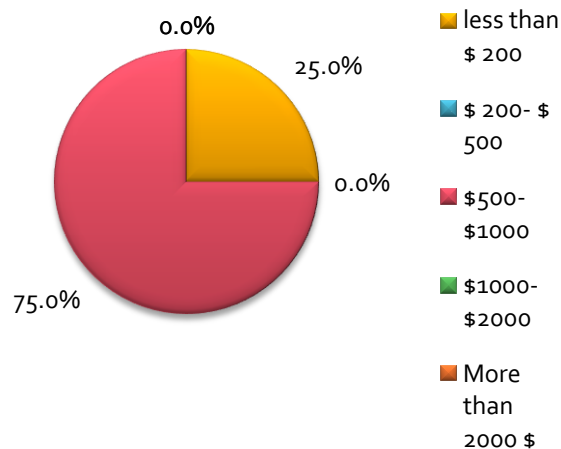
Employability

- 75% of the respondents have an average first monthly salary between 500-1000\$.

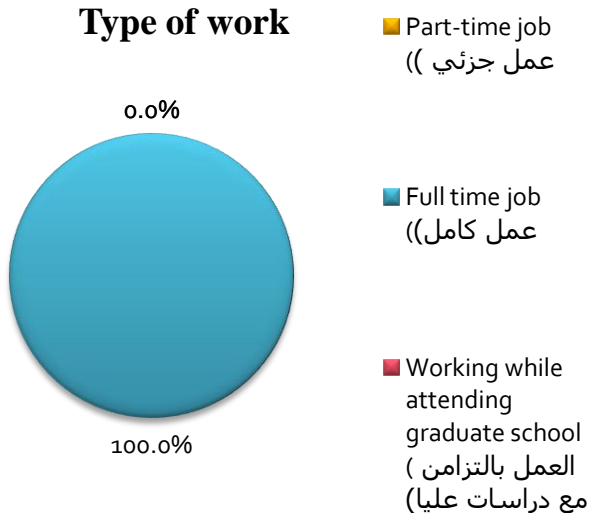
Type of organization



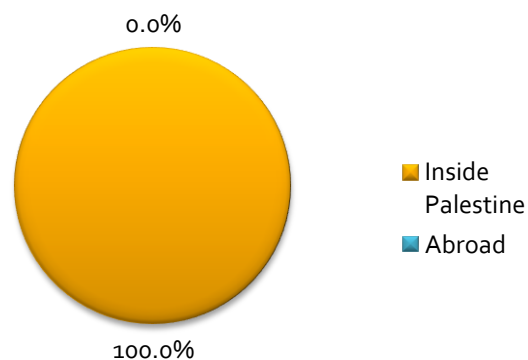
Your monthly salary ?

Your work place ?

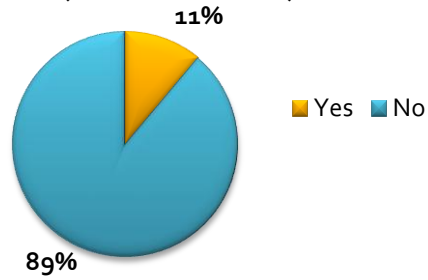

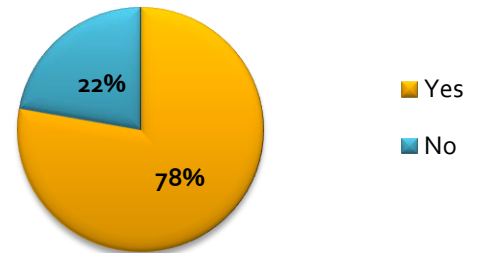

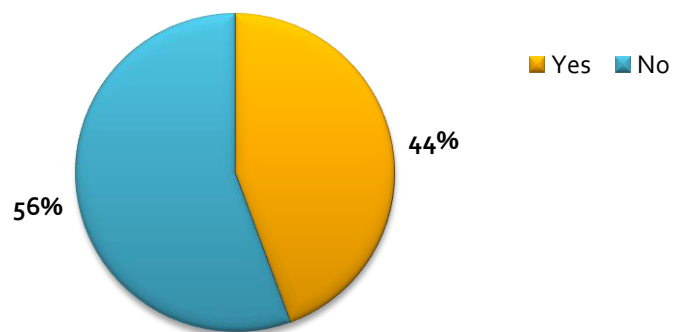
Did you pursue, or are you currently pursuing graduate studies (Masters or PhD)?

Have you attended training courses?

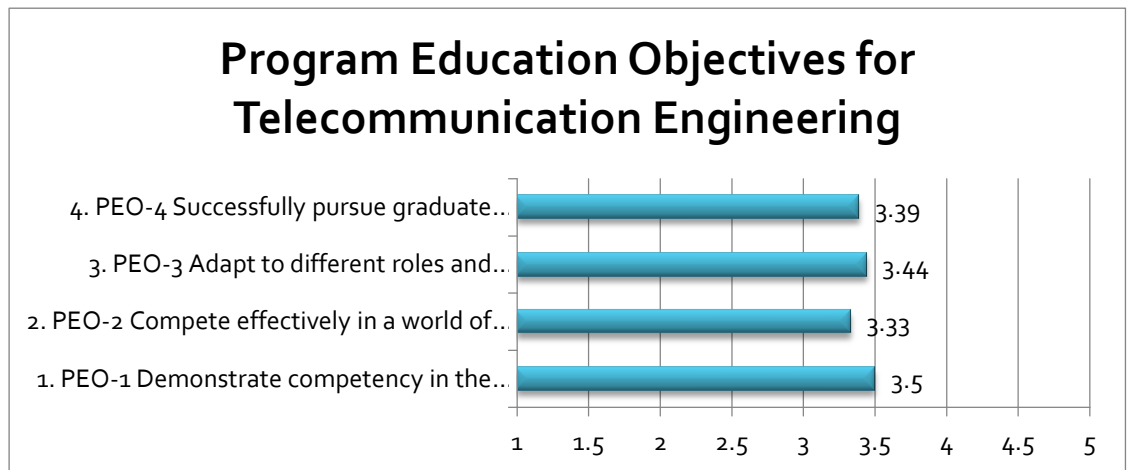


Self Improvement
