A total number of 122 employers responded to the survey, 18 of whom were from the Computer Engineering Program.

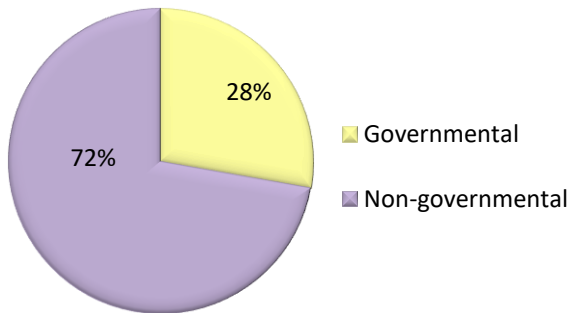
Most of the respondents are employers in non-governmental organizations; also more than half of the organizations have less than 100 employees.

The employers indicated that they are fairly satisfied with Computer Engineering Program Educational Objectives (PEOs).

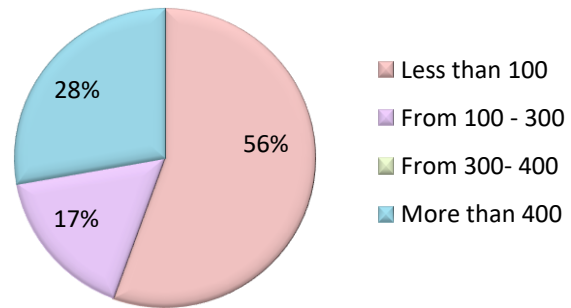

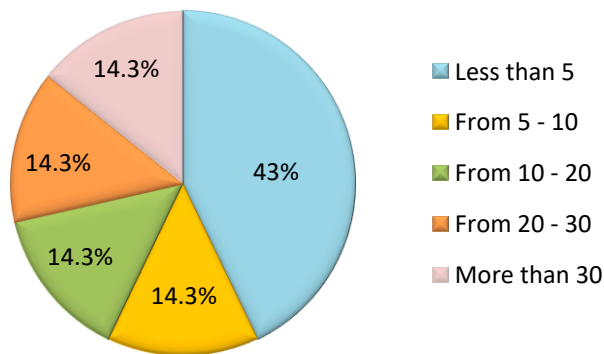
### Type of Business



### Organization Size (Number of Employees)



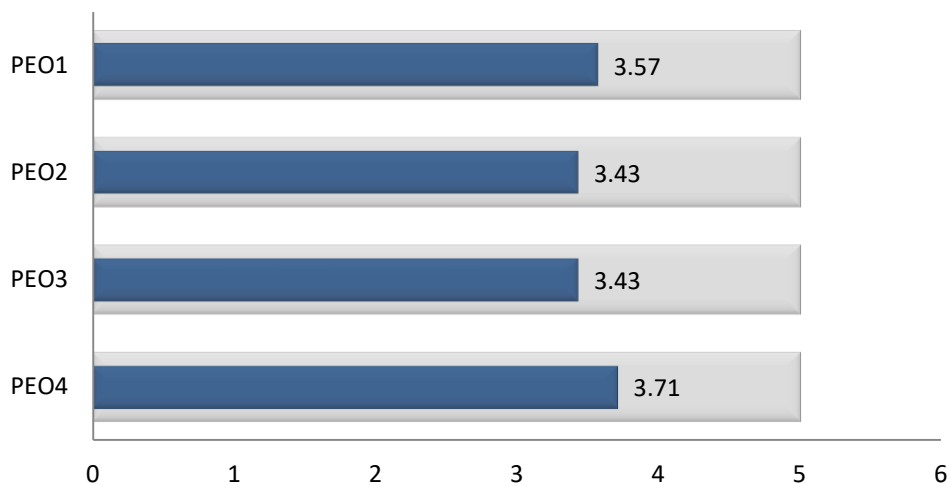
### Number of Computer Engineering Graduates in your organization?

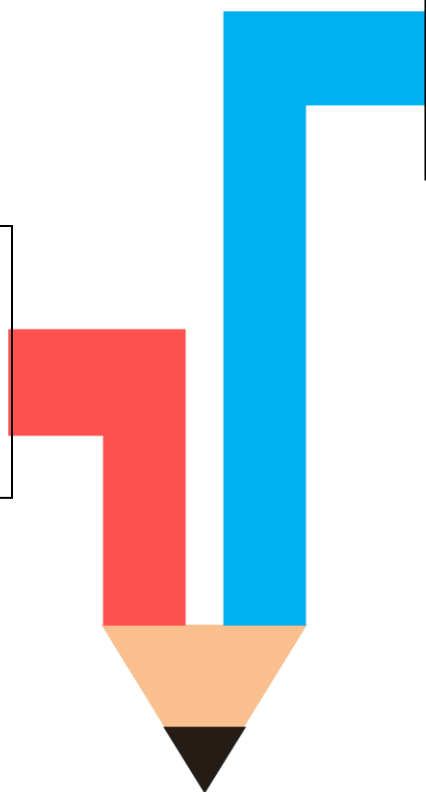
**The Employers' Comments about Computer Engineering Program (program's strengths and deficiencies) were as the following:**
