Introduction

The Quality and Accreditation Unit (ABET center) has recently launched the Alumni Survey for 2022 cycle online. The survey has targeted the Engineering alumni of the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology at An-Najah National University, who were graduated between 2006 to 2019.

The survey aimed at reviewing the Program Educational Objectives (PEOs) of our Engineering Programs to meet the international standards of Quality according to ABET – EAC Criteria, and taking feedback and information from our Alumni about their employability, career progress, and recent endeavours.

Executive summary

A total number of 296 Engineering Alumni responded to the survey, 15 of them were from the Telecommunication Engineering Program.

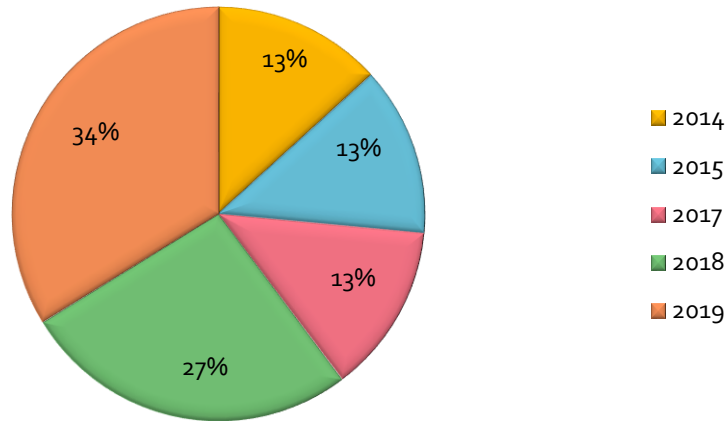
Most of the respondents were among our graduates in the academic years 2018 and 2019. Also, more than half of the respondents were females.

47% of the respondents are currently employed, with a percentage of 100% work inside Palestine.

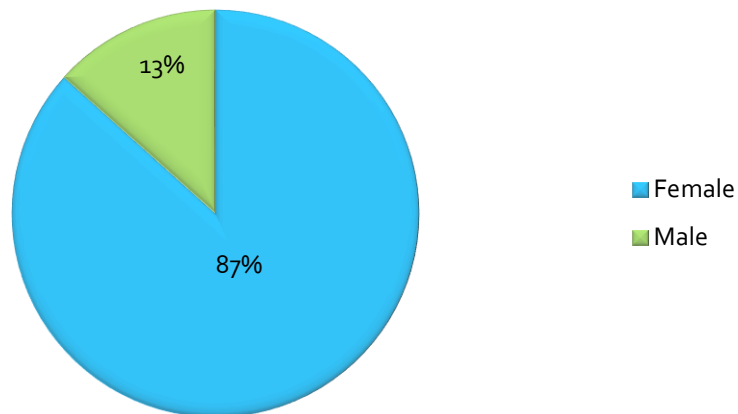

Gender



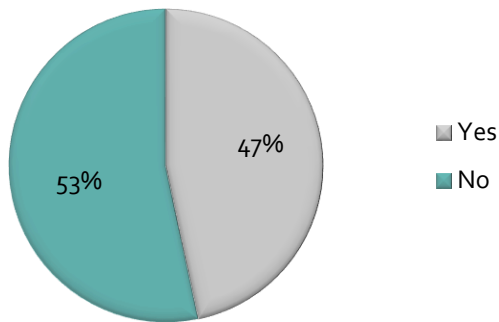
Demographics

- 13% of the respondents were males and 87% were females.

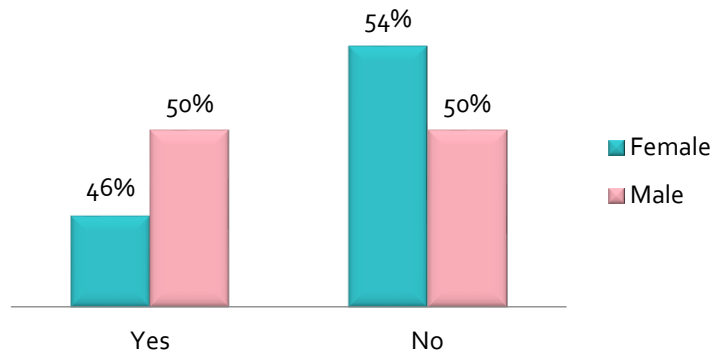

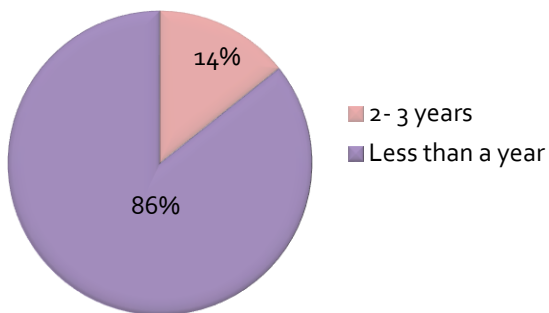
Are You Employed Now?



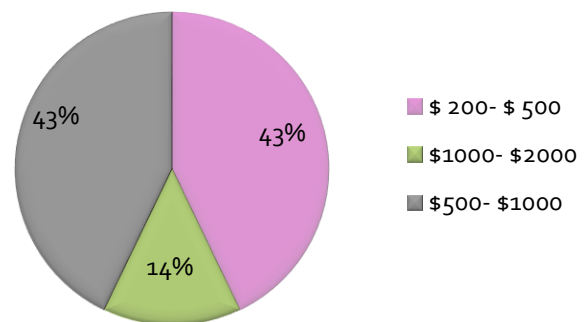
Are You Employed Now?

Period to First Work



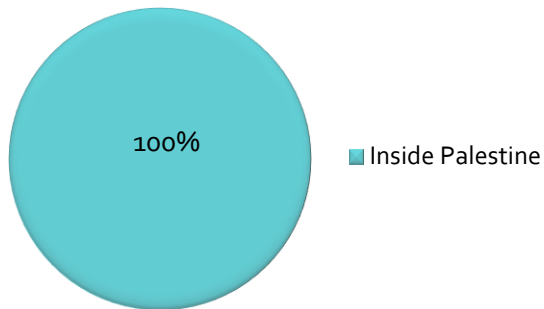
Average Monthly Salary After
Graduation (First Work)



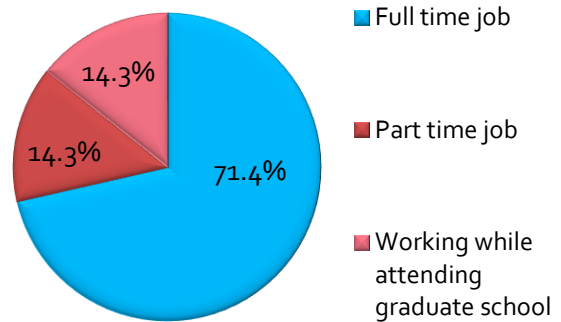
Employability

- An Equal percentage of 43% of the respondents have an average first monthly salary between \$200-\$500 and \$500-\$1000.

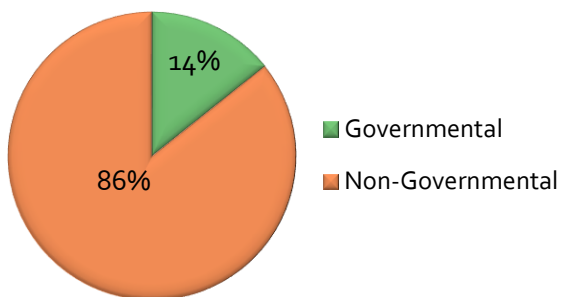
Your Work Place?



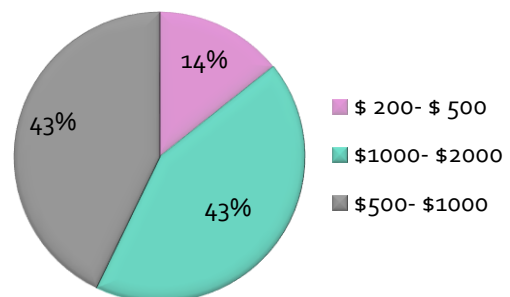
Type of Work

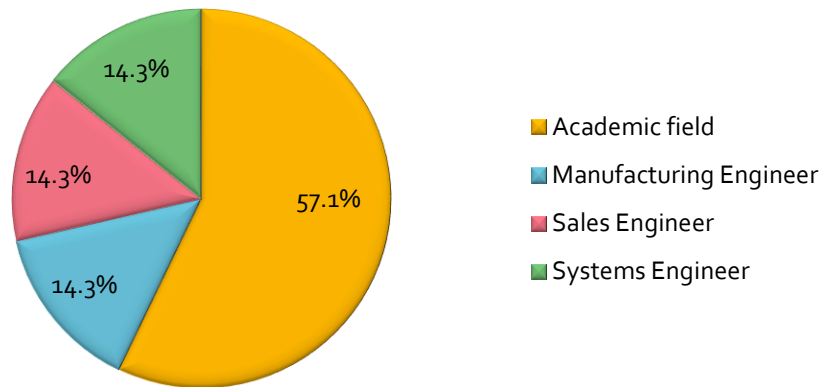


Employability Status:

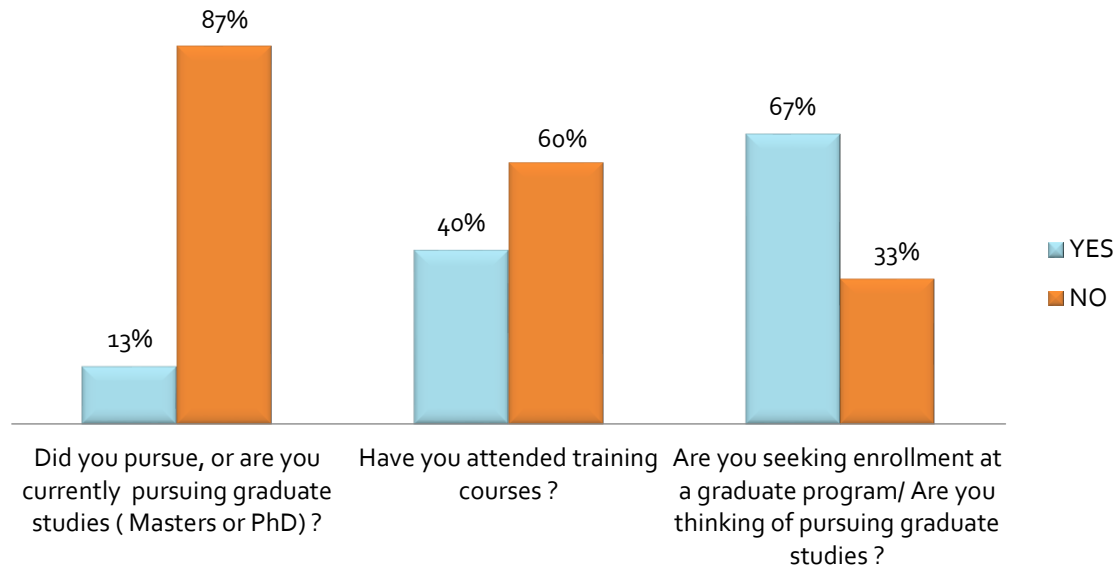
- 71.4% of the employed respondents have a full time job.

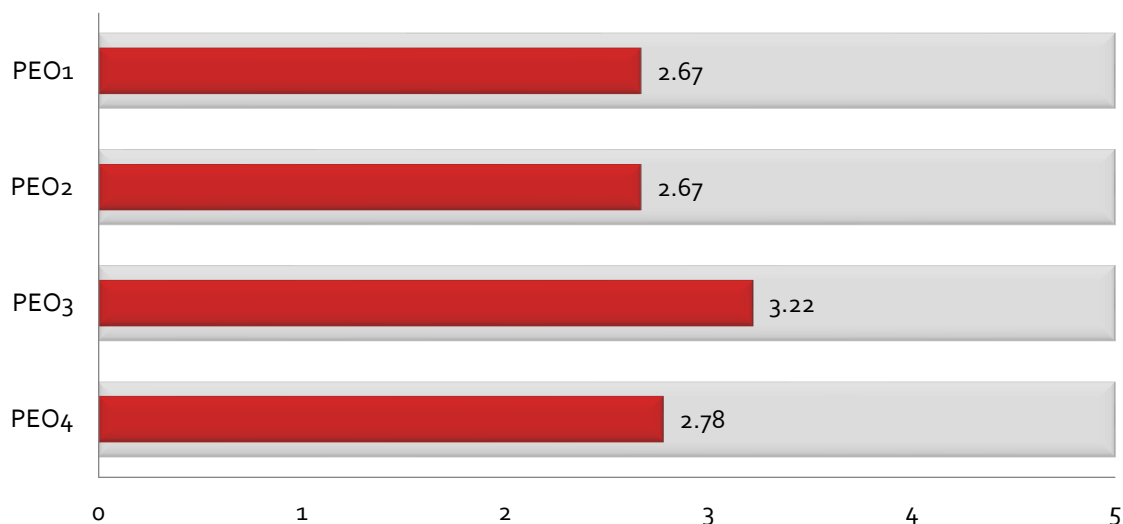


Life Long Learning
