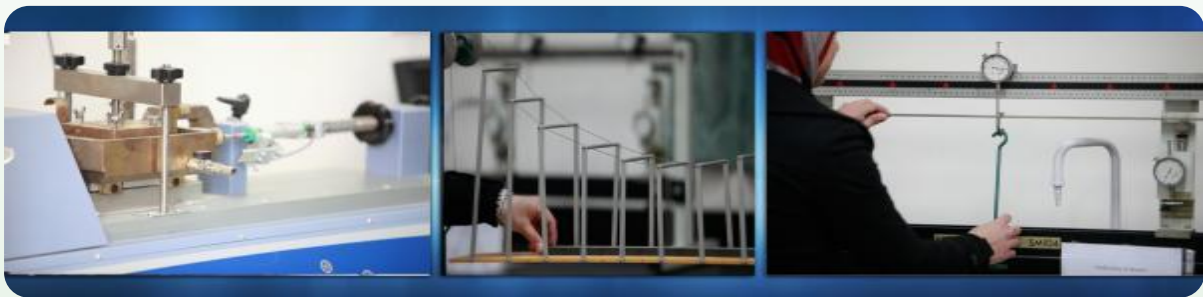

Introduction



The Quality and Accreditation Unit (ABET centre) has recently launched the Alumni Survey 2014 online. The survey has targeted the alumni of the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology at An-Najah National University, who graduated from 2006 to 2013.

The survey aimed at reviewing the Program Educational Objectives (PEOs) of our Engineering Programs to meet the international standards of Quality (ABET), and taking feedback and information from our Alumni about their employability, career progression, and endeavours.



Executive Summary

A total number of 441 alumni responded to the survey, 46 of whom were from the Civil Engineering Program.

Most of the respondents graduated within the past 4 years (2010-2013). Also most of the respondents were males.

Moreover, 28% of the respondents have pursued graduate studies (master, PhD). In addition, 65% of the respondents are currently employed, with a percentage of 73% work inside Palestine.

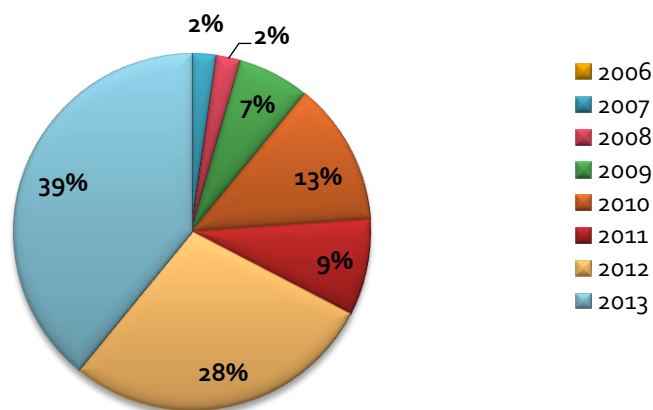
Civil Engineering Program Alumni are employed in various professional positions that are widely spread among the employment sector of 43 % as Site Engineer, 30% as Project Engineer, 10% as Structural Engineer, and 10% Environmental Engineer.

Furthermore, the survey shows that our Alumni receive relatively satisfactory salaries locally and abroad.

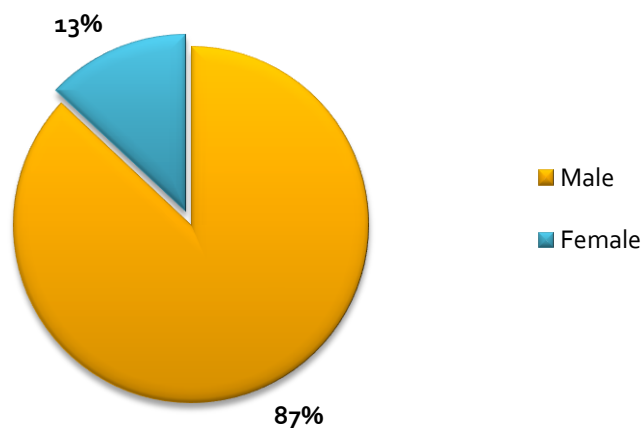
Finally, our Alumni are satisfied with the newly rephrased Civil Engineering Program Educational Objectives (PEOs).

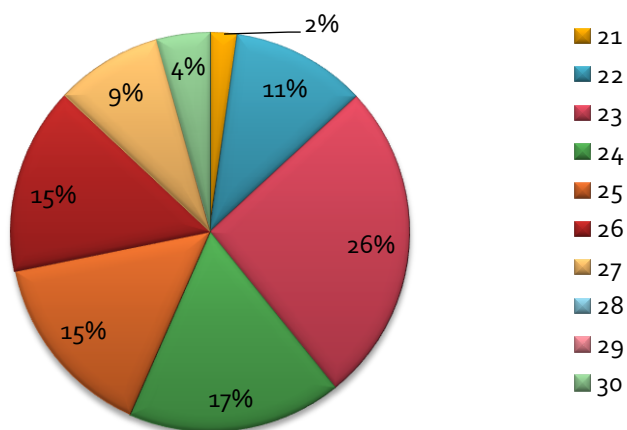
Year of graduation



Gender



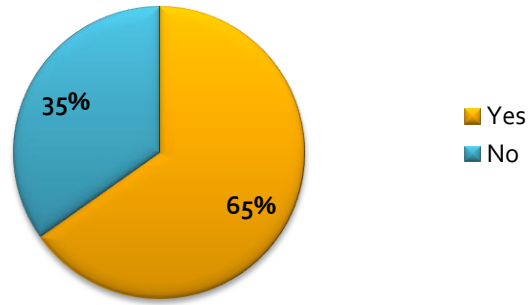

Demographics

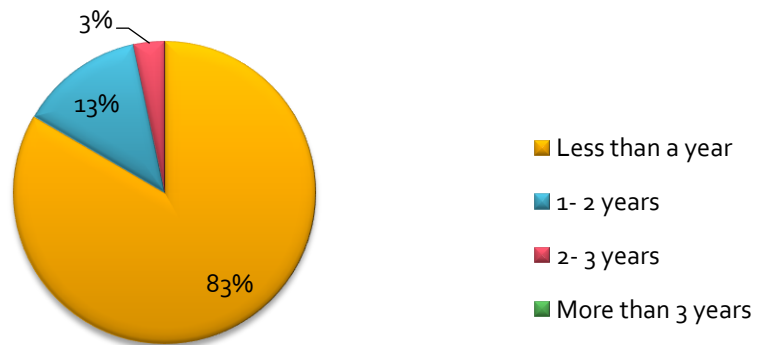
- 89% of the respondents graduated between the years of 2010 and 2013.

Are you employed now?

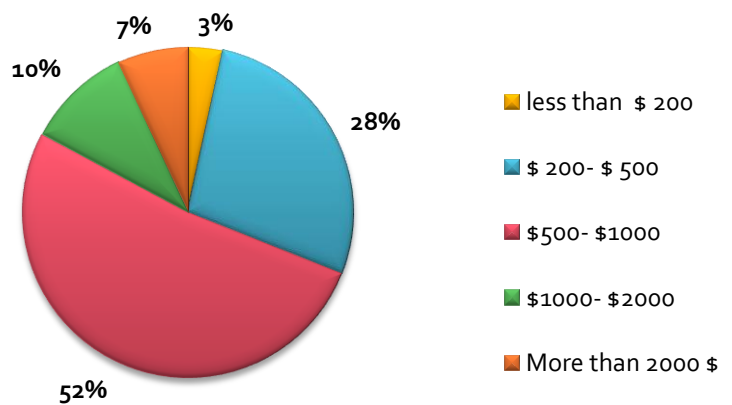

Your average monthly salary after graduation (first work).



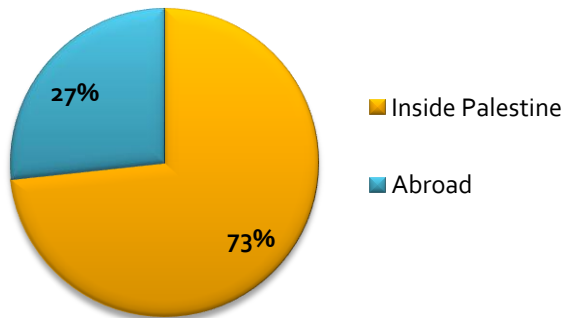
Employability

- 17% of the respondents have an average first monthly salary more than 1000\$.

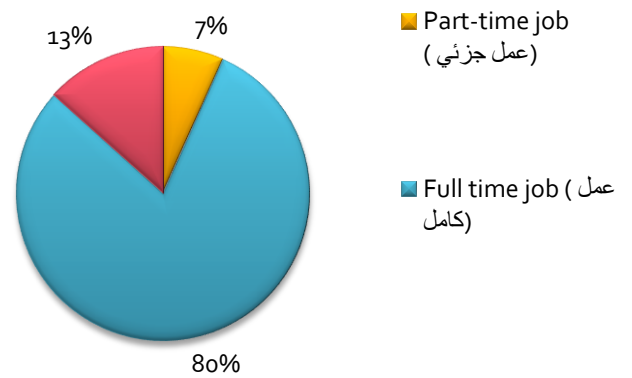
Employability Status

- 45% of the respondents have a monthly salary between 500-1000\$.

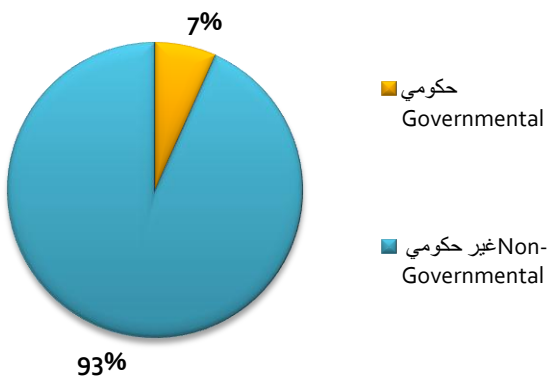
Your work place ?



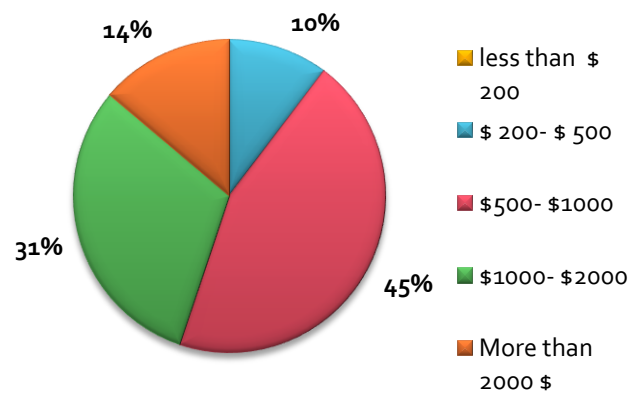
Type of work



Type of organization

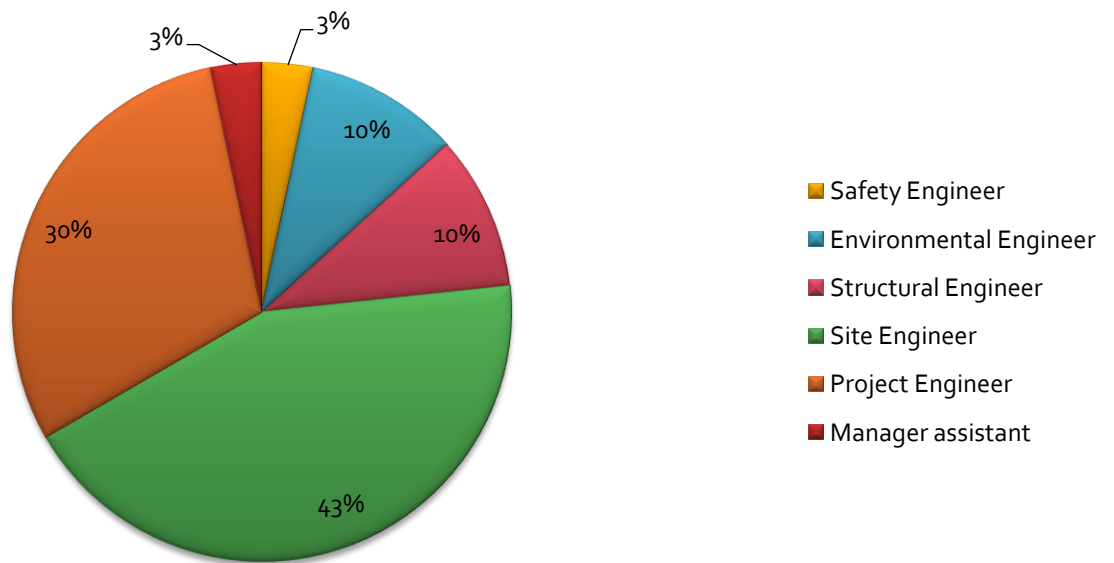


Your monthly salary ?



Top Demanded Job Titles

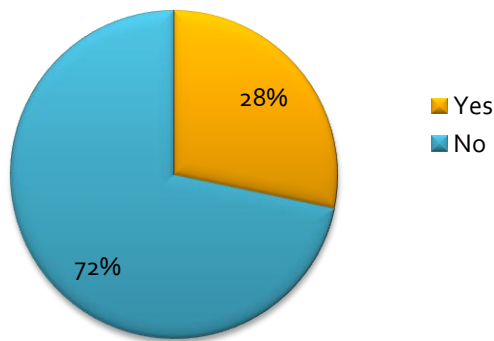

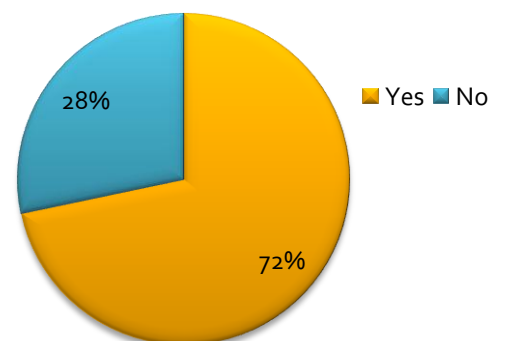
Chapter 3: Self Improvement

- 44% of the respondents attended training courses.

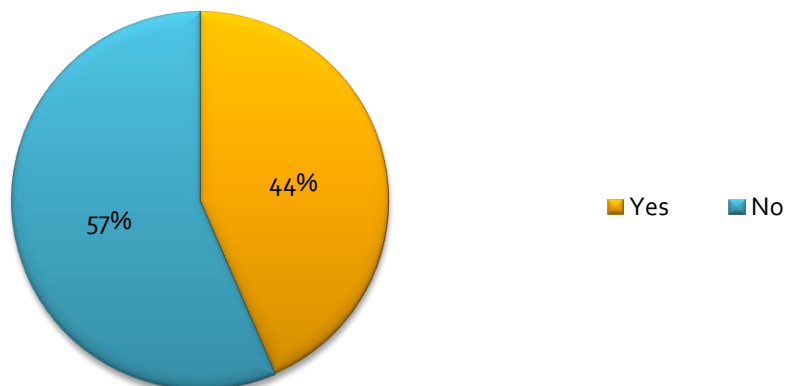
Have you pursued, or are you currently pursuing graduate studies (Masters or PhD) ?



Are you seeking enrollment at a graduate program/ Are you thinking of pursuing graduate studies ?

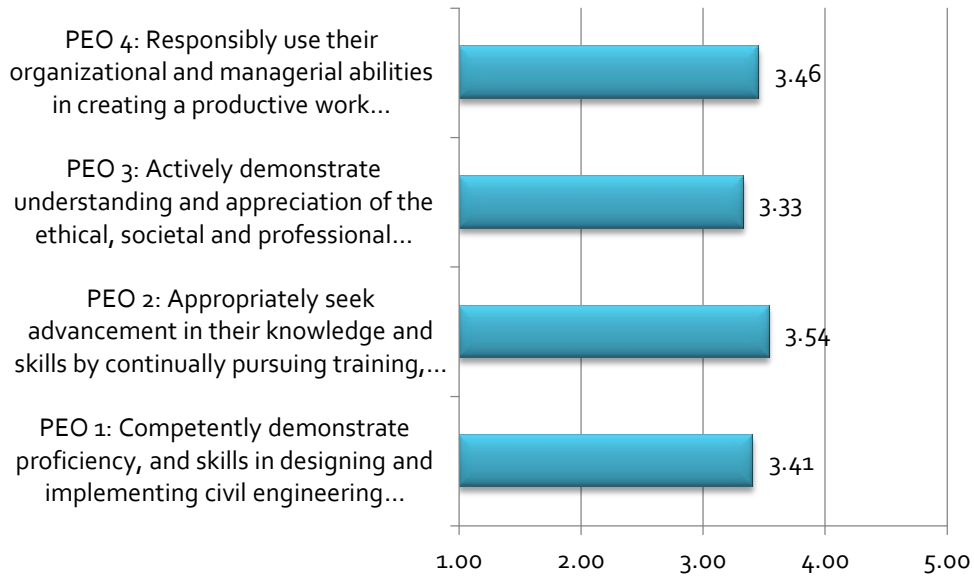


Have you attended training courses ?
