A total number of 122 employers responded to the survey, 5 of whom were from the Chemical Engineering Program.

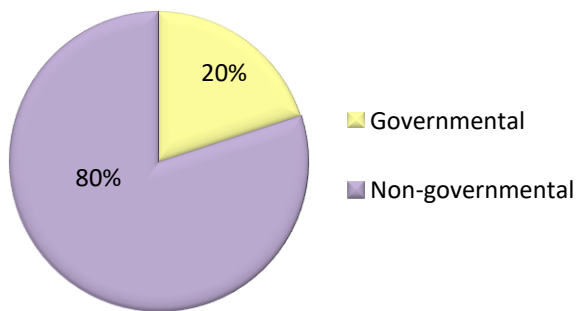
Most of the respondents are employers in non-governmental organizations; also 40% of the organizations have less than 100 employees.

The employers indicated that they are fairly satisfied with Chemical Engineering Program Educational Objectives (PEOs).

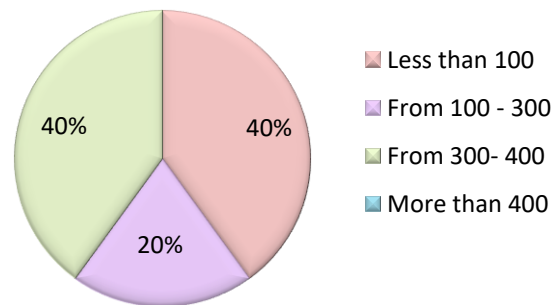

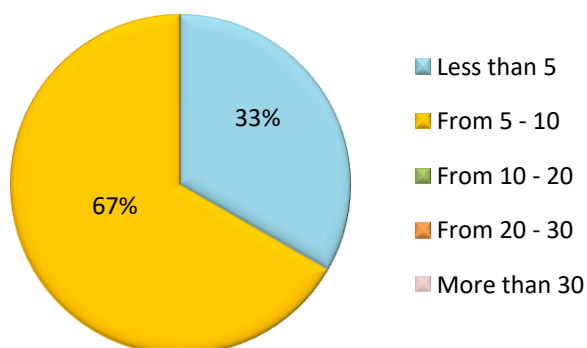
Type of Business



Organization Size (Number of Employees)



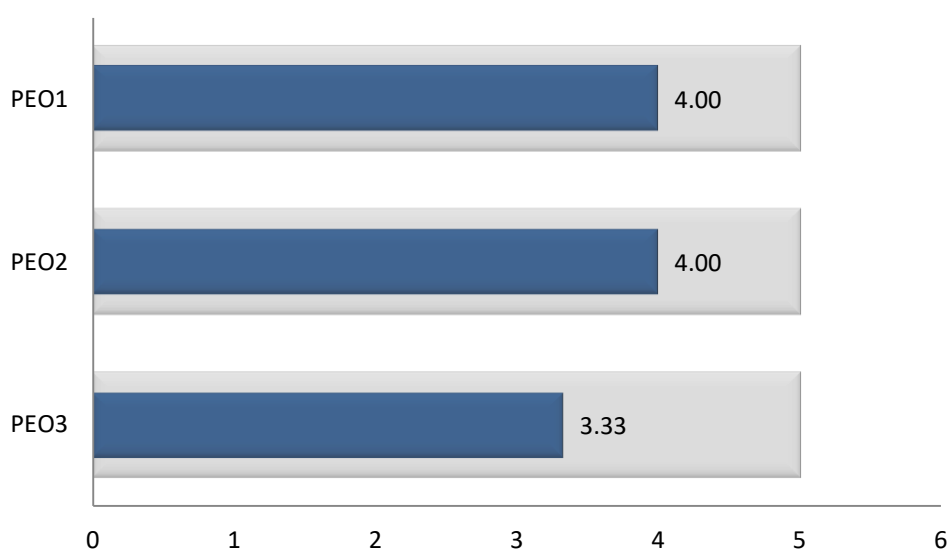
Number of Chemical Engineering Graduates in your organization?

PEOs of Chemical Engineering Program:

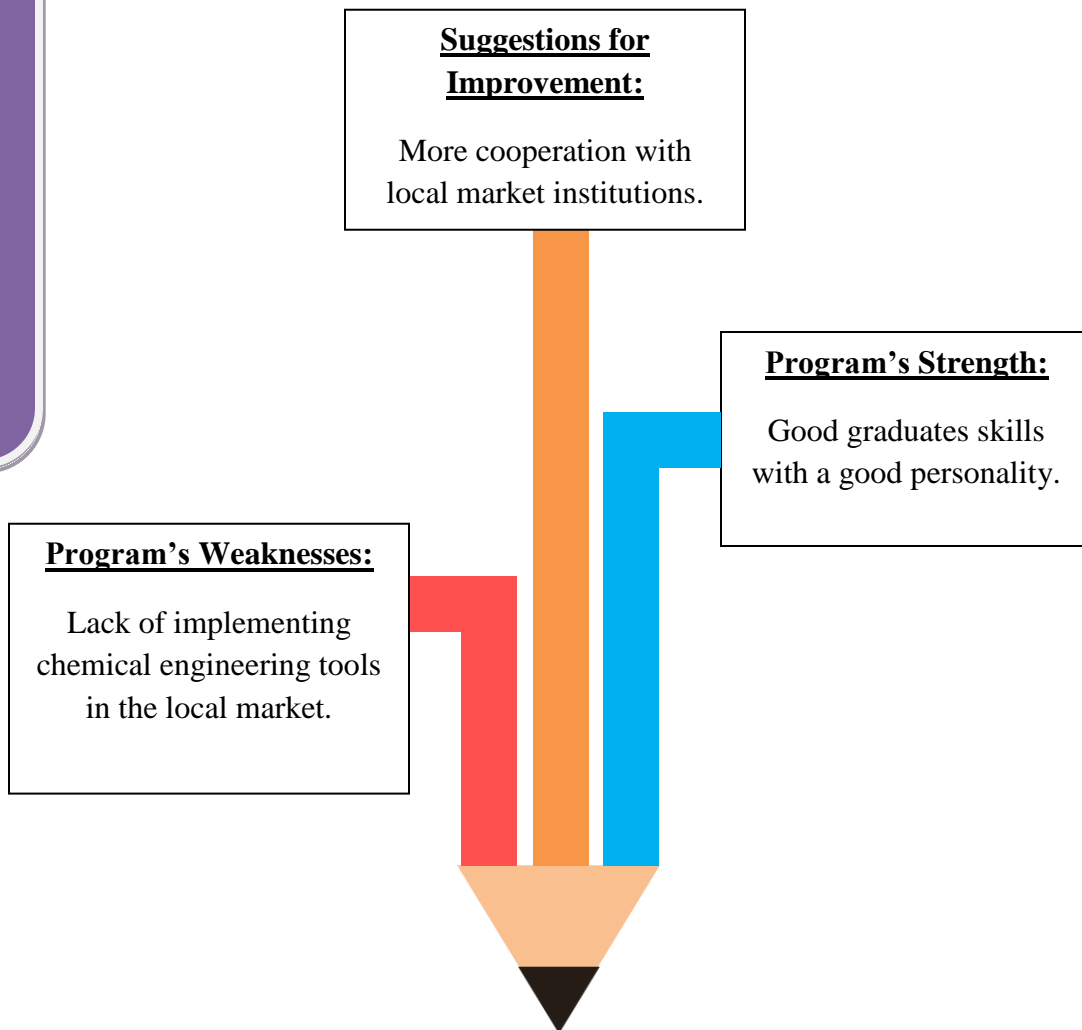
