Alumni Survey Results 2018



Introduction

The Quality and Accreditation Unit (ABET centre) has recently launched the Alumni Survey for 2018 cycle online. The survey has targeted the Engineering alumni of the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology at An-Najah National University, who were graduated between 2006 to 2016.

The survey aimed at reviewing the Program Educational Objectives (PEOs) of the nine Engineering Programs involved in ABET assessment process i.e. Civil, Electrical, Chemical, Industrial, Computer, Mechanical, Mechatronics, Building and Telecommunication Engineering to meet the international standards of Quality according to ABET – EAC Criteria. The survey also aimed at taking feedback and information from our Alumni about their employability, career progression, and recent endeavours.

A total number of 386 Alumni responded to the survey, majority of them (45%) were among our graduates of 2016. It was noticeable from the survey that the employability rate reached 66%, 84% of which found their first job within less than a year of graduation, with a percentage of 74% of Alumni work inside Palestine.


As a conclusion, the survey shows that our graduates are highly demanded locally and abroad, and that they are paid relatively satisfactory salaries.




68 % of respondents graduated between 2013 and 2016.

- *61% male, 39% female.*


Year of Graduation ?




Gender



Top Demanded Job Titles








Employability

- 74% work inside Palestine.


Are You Employed Now?




Period to First Work



Your Work Place ?




Current Monthly Salary
