A total number of 122 employers responded to the survey, 30 of whom were from the Civil Engineering Program.

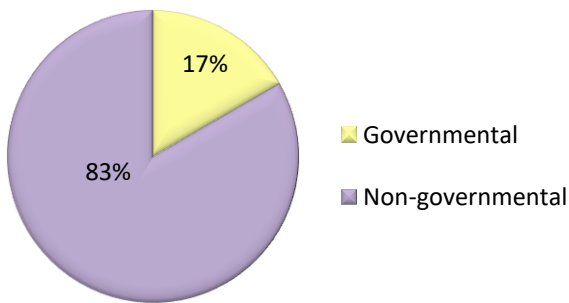
Most of the respondents are employers in non-governmental organizations; also more than half of the organizations have less than 100 employees.

The employers indicated that they are fairly satisfied with Civil Engineering Program Educational Objectives (PEOs).

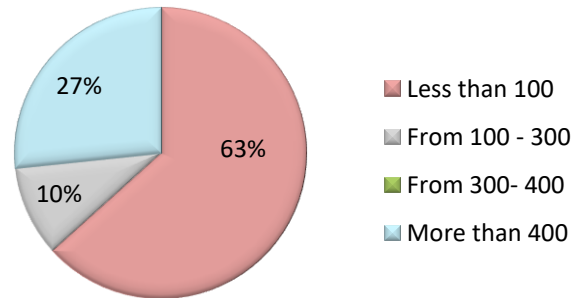

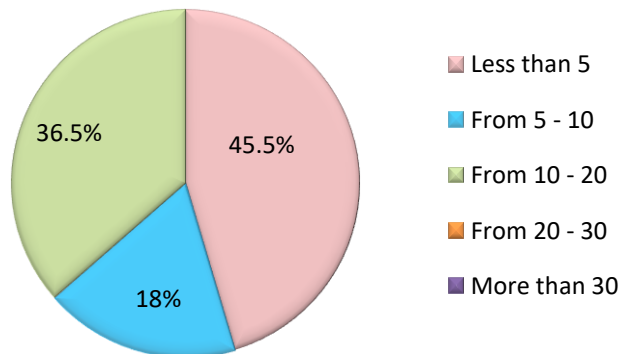
Type of Business



Organization Size (Number of Employees)



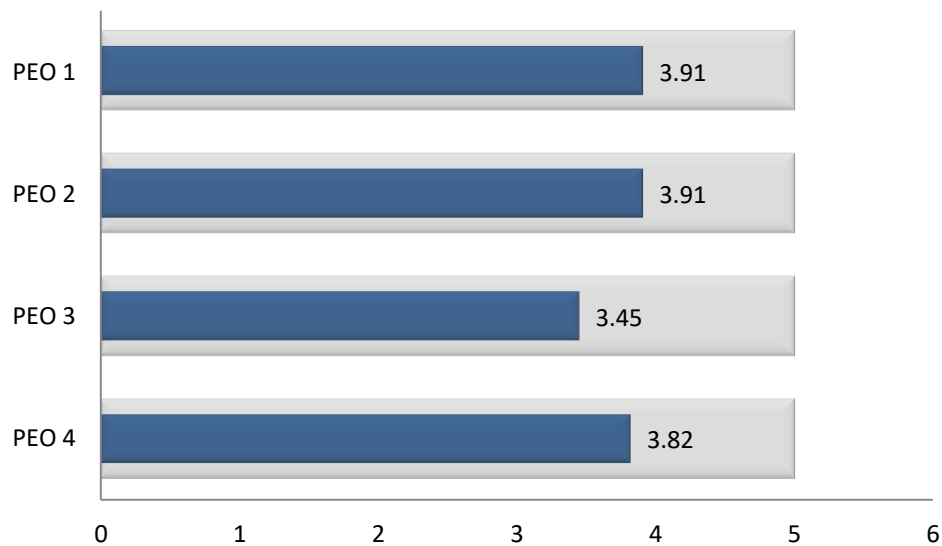
Number of Civil Engineering Graduates in your organization?

PEOs of Civil Engineering Program:

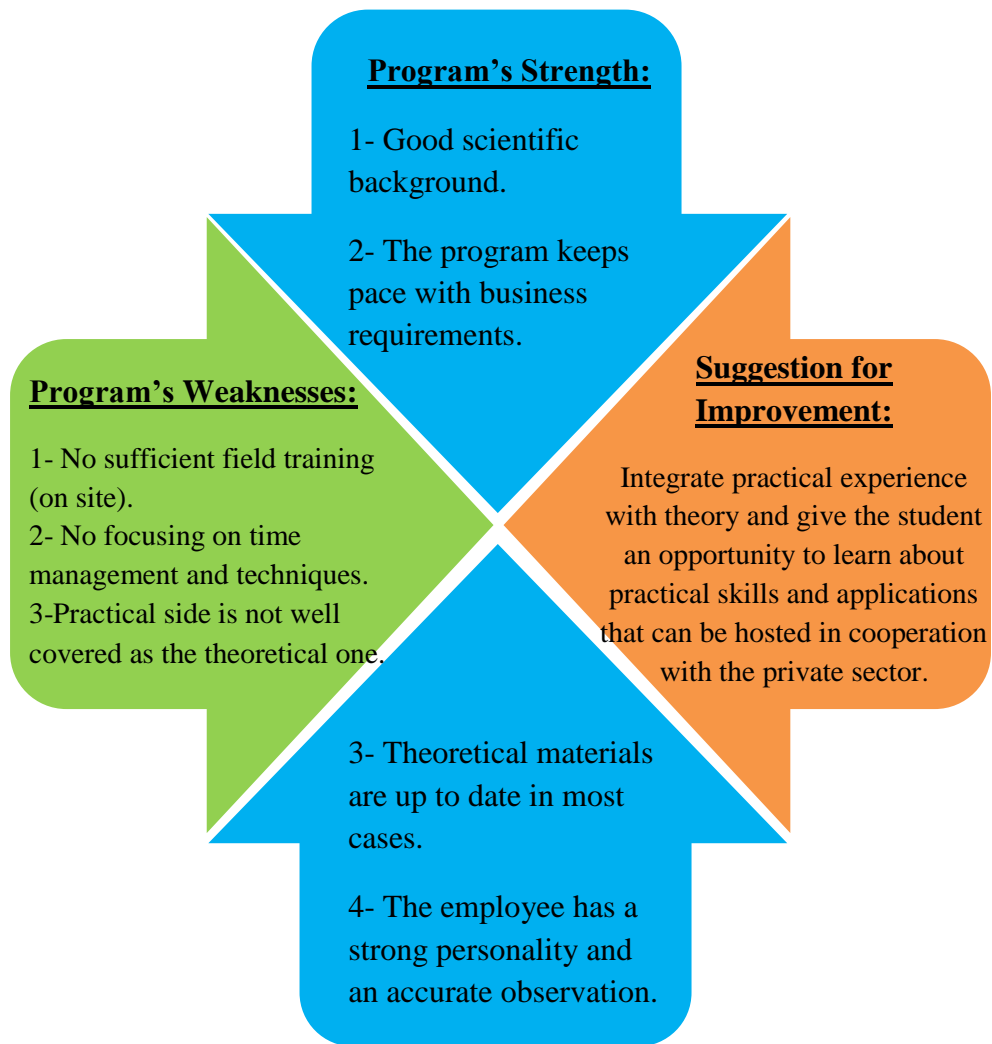
